We will remain open by appointment only for **triaging and managing dental emergencies**. All elective and routine care will be postponed until we return to the office.

If you have an upcoming cleaning, elective/cosmetic case or other non-emergency visit scheduled within March 18-April 10, 2020, please consider your appointment canceled. A member of our front office will reach out to you by phone when we have been given clearance from the Washington State Dental Association and Wa. St. Dept. of Health to re-open. We will be expanding our services hours as soon as its reasonably safe to do so to accommodate rescheduled appointments starting in May 18th unless otherwise advised by local officials.
